Subject - "To Forgive!"

1. St. Luke 23:34
 - While it is hard for us to forgive, this is what Christians are called to do.
 - Jesus provides the genuine model of how we should forgive.
 - Why do people do things against what God tells us to do?
 - Ignorance – when one does not know what they are doing; lack of knowledge
 - Arrogance – thinking too highly of oneself
 - God is calling for us to be humble, walk with others, love one another, etc.
 - The Results of Unforgiveness
 - Separation between you, others, and God
 - Burdens the heart and the soul
 - Unforgiveness causes God not to forgive us
