Subject: "Can You Hear God Marching?"

Notes:

Premise: Jesus said, "My sheep know my voice." So then, how do spirit-filled believers know, with confidence, the voice of God? How can we interpret events through the eyes of God? We must be able to discern His voice and know the role we have in helping God achieve His victories!

Takeaways:

1. **Satan's main objective is to prevent us from using our anointing. He attacks us because he's terrified of God's anointed. The anointing positions us to defeat demonic warfare.**
 2. **Spirit-filled believers must take nothing for granted. We must keep our ears to God's mouth. This is His way of helping us know when He is moving, so that we can move with Him to conquer.**
 3. **God works for His people in every situation. We cannot miss what He is saying about anything! We have God's spirit, so that we are never out of step with His will. He fills us with Himself, so that we will know how and when to engage in spiritual warfare.**
- David is the one who conquered and killed Goliath. In today's message, he is much older and he is anointed King of Israel. In this text, he is faced with the same enemies...the Philistines, which he came up against when he was a boy.
 - In our text, the word "going" in the Hebrew means "marching".
 - Rather than getting angry with what's going on in the world today or in your life, ask God about His will!

- Charles Dickens wrote in his Tale of Two Cities, “It was the best of times and the worst of times, all at the same time.”
- No matter what, out of the ashes, still we rise!!! With God, ALL things are possible!!!
- The spirit of discernment gives us both the Word of God and the Holy Spirit!
 - If you don’t use it, you will not know the voice of God versus the voice of satan.
- Spend time in prayer and you will know when the spirit of discernment is operating in you.
 - God speaks to us and gives us the gift of discernment!
 - Discernment will ask you, “If I do...What is God trying to accomplish?”
 - Try the spirit by the spirit and line it up with the Word of God.
- The anointing positions us to defeat satan. So, don’t lose your anointing, meaning don’t ignore the anointing in you!

Point 1: My anointing assures me God is working for me!

- Jesus will work it out, if you let Him.
- God is not spooky! The Word of God is the assurance that God is real and His Holy Spirit lives in us!
- Learn the benefits of walking with and living for God.
- We must learn how to operate in the Spirit.
- Don’t allow satan to distract you from reading the Word of God!!! He wants to throw us off track.
- Don’t ignore the gifts in our young people either! God speaks and uses them too!
- Sometimes, God has to test you!
 - There has to be a period of testing and maturing, so that you can walk in your calling. Wait on God!!!
- God wants to get us to a place where we are anointed and appointed.
- You must walk into your appointed time. God works in and through time.
- When satan knows that you are anointed, he’s coming after you. He wants to stop you from hearing from God.
- When you are anointed, you can hear from God!!!
 - God, help us not to create a mess!
 - God help us to discern your voice and to be able to distinguish it from the voice of satan.
- Your blessing is not just about you; it’s about God using you to fulfill His glory. It’s about what God wants you to do for Him!
- If you go to God in prayer, God will meet you there.
- Don’t take things for granted. Be grateful for everything!

Point 2: Move with God or not at all!

- Sometimes, it just pays not to move.
- Satan wants us to make one wrong step because he knows that one wrong step gets us off track.
- When it is the Holy Spirit, you can always confirm it with God’s word.
 - You will know it is God when you ask God about it through prayer.
- You must make your decisions by asking God, “What will happen if I do...”.
- We must fast and pray!!! There are some things that can only come through fasting and praying.
- Is God leading you???
- Sometimes, it’s time for battle and sometimes, it’s time to just sit back and wait.
- Every battle is between God and satan. The battle is the Lord’s!
- Sometimes, God will open up a door or a window.
- Sometimes, He will let you be up and sometimes, He will let you be down.
- You must ask God, “Shall I move now or shall I wait and move later?”
- Don’t move unless God tells you to move!
- Stay in the will of God no matter what!!!
- If something must happen for you, it has to first happen in the Heavens first.
- Are you ready for victory???
- Yes, I am ready for VICTORY!
- Listen for God’s call...no matter what situation you are in, God is working!
- Sooner or later, God will say...

Point 3: “Get up! It’s marching time!”

- When you hear the sound of God, that means God is in front of you!
- You don’t want to move forward with God in back of you. You want God to go before you.

- The Almond tree is symbolic of the oil and anointing of God.
- The Palm tree is symbolic of strength.
- The Mulberry tree/Balsam tree is known as the weeping tree because of the sap that fell from it, which represents the oil of healing. It's also called the Balm in Gilead.
- Get in prayer because God wants to heal you!
- When you go through something, it drains you physically, mentally, and spiritually.
- Position yourself to hear from God. Position yourself to hear the sound of marching.
- When you go in prayer and sit there long enough, you'll hear the sound of marching.
- Don't go into the battle when your flesh is leading you.
- March behind God because He is your shield.
- Stop and pray!
- Put your situation in His hands!!!
- Then, you will hear God say, "Go get your victory!!!" God had already fought the battle and won for us!!!
- In this season, you want to hear swords clashing, chains falling, the feet of your enemies running away from you, and God marching!
- Listen to the Spirit!!!
- Fear not because trouble don't last always!
- Trust in the Lord always!!!
- Walk, talk, pray, and stay in the Spirit! Your enemies have already been defeated!!!
- Have you asked God where you are going lately?
- Don't set your own agenda and schedule.
- Make sure you add God to your daily schedule.
- If God is not on your daily schedule, then He is not in your life!
- Don't ask God questions that you already know the answers to.
- Get up, read God's Word, and pray! Set yourself up for living right!!!
- Do things God's way!!!
